CLASS NORMS:

CONSEQUENCES OF RULE VIOLATIONS: [Please note this does not apply to campus violations]

1st violation: Verbal warning with consequence carried out (switch desks, disruptive item confiscated)

2nd violation: Teacher-Student conference

3rd violation: Lunch detention to be served that day or the next

4th violation: 30 minute detention before/after school plus a phone call or email home

5th violation: Referral to the office

Severe violations may result in an instant detention or referral to the office.

EXTRA CREDIT

Opportunities may arise during the course for extra points. These points are at the discretion of the teacher. Extra credit assignments will not be generated to simply improve a grade. Please do not request extra credit. Any extra-credit given is at the sole discretion of the teacher and may not exceed 5% of the student's total average.

LATE WORK

Assignments are due at the **beginning of the period** or when requested by the teacher. Late work will not be accepted after 10 calendar days of the due date. Students who miss class for scheduled school activities (sports, performing arts, etc...) must meet the same assignment deadlines as other students and turn in assignments that are due before a scheduled event. **Participation in a school activity does not extend the due date.** Late work will be graded at teacher's convenience. Students should discuss late work opportunities with the teacher during office hours or via email, not during instructional time.

ATTENDANCE/MAKE-UP WORK

If you are absent, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FIND OUT WHAT YOU MISSED. Students can visit the "Agenda" tab of my website to see what we did. **Your absence is not an excuse for missing work. If you cannot complete the assignment before it is due, please ask me for an extension at least two days prior to the deadline. Extensions may/may not be granted, it depends on the individual circumstances.** Students absent when the work is due will turn it in upon their return, unless it is a Google Classroom assignment.

FINALS

Each student must take the final and/or complete all final projects and papers within the time that is allotted for finals; these activities and assignments have a major impact on the overall semester grade.

PLAGIARISM/CHEATING

Plagiarism and/or cheating are serious offenses, and will be treated as such. If you cheat or plagiarize any assignment, in whole or in part, you will receive an "F" for the assignment. This is a school-wide policy.

TUTORING/OFFICE HOURS

I will be available during Lunch on Thursday and after school by appointment only.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Cell phones must be turned off and put away during class time unless the teacher has specifically given permission allowing the student to use the device to complete a specific curriculum-related assignment.

1st offense Teacher warns student that device will be confiscated and "logs" the offense

2nd offense Teacher confiscates the device for the duration of the class period and "logs" the offense
