You will be watching a news story from CNN10 to report on. You can choose any story from the current week. You are not reporting on the whole episode, just a story within the episode. This **does not** mean reporting on the story at the end of the episode. You will be required to present the following information on the topic.

| When did the event happen? This could be a specific date, or maybe it was a month ago? Yesterday? Last week? Next week? Today? | Who was involved? Are there groups involved? Is it one person? Be specific on the groups involved. If they have no name then describe them. For example, "teen girls". |
| What happened? Here is where you are going to give me a lot of detail. Tell me everything about what happened. This will be in your own words. | |
| Why is this important to us? This is a big question....why should I care? Ask yourself this. Obviously CNN didn't just tell you this story for nothing..what might their reason be? | |
| What is one question you have that was not answered by this story? Pretend that person in the story is in front of you. What is something you might ask that person or group. | Is this GRAPES related? Remember these? This is asking if it is related to any of the following topics: Geography, Religion, Achievements, Politics, Economics, or Social structure.
